DATE	TOPIC
11 th September 2008	OPEN Any subject, which has strong pictorial appeal, e.g. good composition & lighting
9 th October 2008	STILL LIFE A photograph of a pictorial arrangement of inanimate objects whether natural or man made or a combination of both. Synthetic scenes made up from models are described as “Table Top” and are excluded. & PEOPLE*
13 th November 2008	OPEN Any subject, which has strong pictorial appeal, e.g. good composition & lighting
11 th December 2008	ANNUAL AWARDS DINNER
8 th January 2009	OPEN Any subject, which has strong pictorial appeal, e.g. good composition & lighting.
13 th February 2009	CLOSER THAN ONE METRE Any photograph taken when the camera lens is less than one metre from the main subject. This title could be used as an alternative to “Macro Photography or “Close Up”, to encourage beginners who may not have sufficient technical knowledge to use more sophisticated equipment. & PEOPLE*
12 th March 2009	OPEN Any subject, which has strong pictorial appeal, e.g. good composition & lighting.
