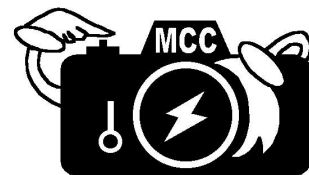

CHRISTIAN FLETCHER PHOTOGRAPHIC WORKSHOP

The club has arranged a photographic workshop to be run by the highly regarded WA landscape photographer, Christian Fletcher. The workshop will be held on Saturday 18th September at a local venue that has still yet to be finalised. I would like to acknowledge the work done by Roy Bolton in setting up this event, and I'm sure that all who attend will gain some really valuable insights into the way Christian weaves his magic over the outstanding images he produces.

This workshop will run for approximately 4 hours, with further time as needed for a question and answer session. The committee has determined the cost to be \$75 per member (\$100 non-members), which also includes a light lunch. If you are interested in attending, please bring your payment to next week's club meeting to register.

Topics that will be covered include: Composition; light; equipment and software; shooting in Camera Raw; Raw image conversion; working in Photoshop, with examples to follow through; noise reduction; image interpolation techniques; stitching panoramas; colour management; colour working spaces; Photoshop colour settings; soft proofing; monitor calibration; ICC profiles used for getting great prints; printers and media that Christian uses; image resizing; sharpening for print and web; tips and tricks such as local contrast enhancement; the use of blend modes; and software products that can add some flair to your images.

Christian will also talk about his background and how he has managed to be so successful in this industry. The emphasis on this workshop will be on his digital workflow, and how you will be able to apply that to your own images.
