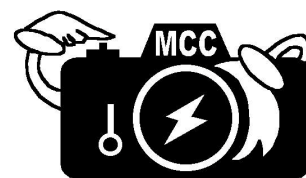

The competition topic this month is PHOTOJOURNALISM (A record of any event which tells a story of what has happened, is happening, or is about to happen, the visual sight of which excites or stimulates one of the many human emotions).

Our Judge for this competition will be Anthony Matthews. Anthony has been a professional picture framer since 1992, becoming a partner in Mandurah Picture Framing in 2001. In 2006 he expanded the business by purchasing a large format inkjet printer. Following studies in IT at TAFE (one of my stand-out students!), Anthony started a new computer support business offering a full range of IT solutions, and retains the large format digital printing side of the picture framing business. #### **CAPE NATURALISTE EXCURSION**

## **BUNBURY FORUM INTERCLUB COMPETITION**

Please remember to bring your images in on Monday's club night for the Bunbury Forum Interclub competition. Dates for display, if you can make a trip down to Bunbury, are 19-22 May (19th being set up, with evening presentation for clubs, coffee, etc).

The competition topic is "Our South West" (An image showing any feature, aspect or activity within the South West of Western Australia). The categories are Colour Print and Mono Print (mono is any photograph containing shades of only ONE colour. If toning is carried out, it must be over the total photograph. Partial toning and/or the addition of one extra colour will not be accepted). There is no minimum print size, only the maximum of 40x50cm, including mount. We need to select 10 entries in each category (with no more than two per member) for the competition.

The topic for the exhibition at the Bunbury Forum is Open. The original entry form limited the number of exhibition prints to ten, but as Margaret River are not participating this year, we can provide as many images as we like (within reason) for the exhibition. The exhibition is separate from the competition.

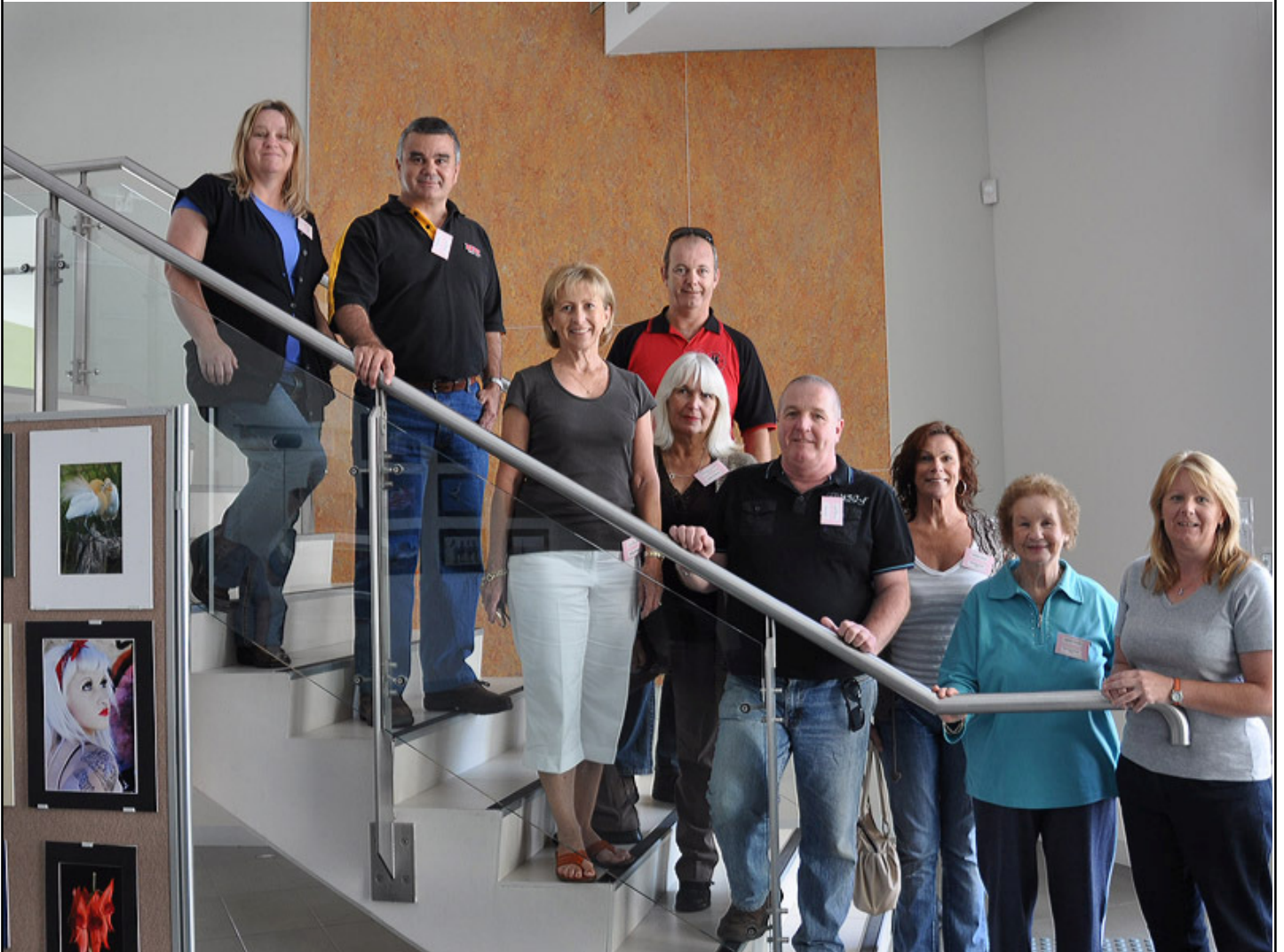
## **PERTH NATIONAL PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION**
